1 Film Fabric™ Resources Module - Overview

Film Fabric™ is the Project Management solution for the Film and Television. It will help you to easily store and retrieve information that you use on a day-to-day basis. From a script or idea landing on your desk through readers reports, script revisions, options, selecting cast and crew, contracts, financing, scene scheduling, shooting and daily reporting, Film Fabric will assist you every step of the way.

1.1 Resources Module – What does it do.

The Resources Module is a central repository of your company's contact details and other information about both personnel in the film industry - whether they are cast or crew – and inanimate resources such as locations, catering organisations and equipment hire. This information can be shared across your organisation so that you all have the most up to date information.



Both the Development and Production modules use the Resources database to refer to people who are being considered for a project (during development) and who then actually work on or appear in a green-lit production (during production).

In addition to standard contact information, the resources module also allows you to store representation information such as Lawyers, Managers or Agents. This itself allows you to see at a glance which cast are represented by each agent.

As resources are attached to projects over time, the resources database will build up a history of “project activity”. This is valuable information. If a writer or agent sends you a script you can immediately see what else they have submitted, and what you subsequently did with those submissions.

Resources can be categorised allowing you to see at a glance what writers, agents, lawyers, actors etc. you have information on.

Changes to any contact details for any resources are automatically made available to the rest of the team saving the effort of updating everybody's personal organiser when an agent loses his mobile phone.
